June 2023

June saw Climeworks host their 4th DAC Summit in Zurich followed closely by the Negative Emissions Platform's CDR Summit in Brussels which gave the DAC Coalition and broader CDR community a chance to connect with their global peers and colleagues. The UN Article 6.4 Supervisory Body continued its exploration into removals and how to govern their international trading with a follow-up public consultation. You can see the Direct Air Capture Coalition's response here.



Market Updates

- The UK's **Department of Energy Security and Net-Zero (DESNZ)** announced its intention to support engineered greenhouse gas removal through **Contract for Differences** and opened a Request for Information on how companies can best utilise this scheme.
- \$ Fundraising Galore for DAC Coalition Members Cella, an enhanced mineralisation company based out of New York and Nairobi, announced their \$3.3m Seed fundraising round led by Counteract and the Grantham Foundation. Skytree, a Dutch-based DAC company focusing on decentralised units, completed a \$6m Seed round led by Horticoop and Yield Lab Europe as they look to elevate DAC's role within the Agtech and

horticultural industries. **Nori**, a blockchain based carbon removal marketplace, raised \$6.25 million in new funding with current investors M13, Toyota Ventures, Placeholder and Cargill leading the round.

- Nori introduced the concept of a carbon removal "blended tonne" in a recent whitepaper. The concept aims to tackle the problem of how to deliver high-quality permanent removals (accepting long wait times for future vintages) with the immediacy required to satisfy net-zero pledges.
- National Energy Technology Laboratory (NETL) announced that their Direct Air Capture Centre, based in Pittsburgh, came is accepting partners with TRL 3-6 with capabilities to test emerging technologies from lab-scale (0.1kgCO2/day) and small scale pilot (30kgCO2/day).
- Georgia Institute of Technology announced the discovery of an approach that could spur "a new generation of DAC systems" using coated carbon fibres and efficient inside-out heating systems. Their electric-temperature swing adsorption method claims to fully regenerate in under 10min and with projected costs to be ~\$160t/CO2. Full paper here.
- Boston Consulting Group and CarbonCapture Inc announce a historical offtake agreement that agrees to <u>remove 40,000 tonnes</u> over the course of five-years, with the global consulting giant to offer up their management consulting services too.
- Momentum is growing amongst industry experts for a clear distinction in targets for emissions reductions and removals following a <u>Climeworks</u> statement backed by 40 organisations. An <u>Op-Ed in Fast Company</u> written by Carbon Business Council's Executive Director Ben Rubin punctuates its importance.
- CarbonGap alongside eight other European organisations have called for the European Union to preserve the Net-Zero Industry Act's CO2 injection target of 50Mt/yr by 2030 (recognising the role of CCS, DACCS and BECCS) and notes the obligation of oil and gas producers to contribute to it. Historic global purchases of CO2 removal (tonnes)



The factory will expand its 2.4GWh production to 90GWh of capacity making it the largest battery factory in the world.

Nordic DAC Group, Carbon Removal AS and Nordic Travel Group has signed a Letter of Intent to collaborate on DAC at CarbonRemovalAS NorDAC project in Øygarden. When operational, the plant will be a capable of removing 0.5MtCO2/yr using Carbon Engineering's tecnology.
